ENGLISH

Learning Objective:

- Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters. (ELG)
- Say a sound for each letter in the alphabet (ELG)
- Read words consistent with their phonic knowledge by sound-blending. (ELG)

Brief Overview of the task:

- Build words together. Write the letters s/a/t/p/i/n on some squares of paper. First practise recognising these sounds. Next, have a go at building and reading the following words: at/in/an/as/it/is/sat/pin/sit/pit/nip/pat/tap/tip by rearranging the letters.

Verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system. (ELG)
