Reverse Advent Calendar Well Supported

A massive thank you to all those parents who have sent their children in with items for the Reverse Advent Calendar throughout the four weeks of the charitable event. We estimate that around 1 in every 4 families contributed something at some point over the 20 days, the best response that we have had since we returned after the pandemic.

The total items donated to us were...

- 93 packets of dried pasta;
- 63 packets of gravy granules;
- 57 packets of dried fruit;
- 42 multipacks of crisps;
- 91 packets of biscuits or crackers;
- 64 bottles of squash;
- 63 bottles of fizzy drink;
- 54 items consisting of tea/coffee/sugar;
- 71 packets of jelly;
- 73 bottles of sauce;
- 69 tins of meat;
- 95 tins of vegetables;
- 67 cans of soup;
- 68 tins of fruit;
- 55 tins of cream/condensed milk;
- 60 bottles of deodorant;
- 62 toothbrushes/toothpaste;
- 42 bottles of washing-up liquid
- 38 packets of toilet roll;
- 18 boxes of Christmas crackers

That is a grand total of 1245 items that have been collected by the Downham Foodbank and which will be distributed to families in need of additional support over the next few days and weeks.

As ever, we are incredibly thankful for your continued support with this annual charitable event.
