#### Life Skills

We are aware that there has been some disquiet amongst some parents of Year 5 pupils regarding the subject matter being discussed within Life Skills lessons at present.

The heavy topic of gender and celebrating everyone's differences is the current area of learning for the Year 5s at present and this is an area that evokes lots of differing opinions amongst adults who can often view the matters being discussed with varying strengths of opinion.

Whatever the views shared by any individual, we are only delivering the subject matter that we have a legal obligation to deliver and not going any further than we are obliged to go nor are we dumbing the subject matter down in any way. It is an important conversation to have and one that primary schools are duty-bound to deliver.

## No Dogs Allowed on the School Site

A reminder to ALL parents and family members who visit Hillcrest at various times that there should be NO DOGS walked or carried onto the school site at any time.

Any parent or family member bringing a dog onto the site will politely be asked to remove their dog by a member of staff. In the event that any parent persistently ignores polite requests to remove their dogs from the school site, the parent themselves will be banned from the school site under powers we hold within the Education Act.

## **Respecting our Neighbours and Respecting Our School Site**

We have experienced a growing number of issues in recent weeks where pupils from Downham Market Academy are not being respectful either to neighbours of the school, or to Hillcrest itself whilst on our site.

We would like to remind everyone that DMA pupils should not be using Hillcrest's playground as a thoroughfare to get from one side of the estate to the other and that they should ONLY be on site if they are collecting a sibling from our school.

We would also like to ask parents who allow their DMA-aged child to collect their younger sibling from Hillcrest to make sure that they are respectful of the other adults and children around them whilst they are waiting to collect and that they wait sensibly.

We have had one particularly upsetting incident where two girls from DMA displayed rude gestures using ther hands towards the children in one of the Year 2 classrooms as they walked past at the end of the day.

In another incident, DMA pupils waiting outside our gate into the KS1 playground on Sandringham Drive, have been throwing items at the front door and into the back garden of one of our neighbours, causing them much distress.

Both the high school and the police have been informed with the police having carried out a patrol in the area in recent days.

## **Sending Cash Into School**

There are very few times when we ask cash to come into school with most payments for lunches, trips and charitable events coming into school via WisePay. However, on those occasions where you have no other choice than to send your child in with cash, please ensure that you send it in within a sealed envelope. On the front of the envelope you should write the amount that can be found within the envelope, your child's name, their class and the purpose for the money.

## **Car Parking**

A reminder to all parents that the school car park is only available for staff members, blue badge holders and those taxis dropping off and collecting children from the SRB. Other parents should not be attempting to drive in through the barrier whilst it is in it's upright position.

#### **Attendance Matters**

Lateness – If a child misses the register at 8.55am but arrives shortly afterwards, they are marked as being present but 'late' right up until 9.25am. However, children arriving after 9.25am with no valid reason will receive an unauthorised absence in the register for the morning even though they have eventually turned up for school. Please don't let lateness become a habit as every minute of schooling missed really counts over the course of a year.
